- B. returned to them by marking an "R" on the tag.
 - 1. Must pick up unsold items no later than 12:00 pm on Saturday, May 3rd.
 - 2. ALL ITEMS UNCLAIMED BY 1:00 pm WILL BE DONATED TO CHARITY

PRICING AND TAGGING ITEMS

- 1. Sign up by emailing (consignor number. Your consignor number stays the same year to year.
- 2. Prepare your tags. (Please remember someone counts these tags by HAND, try and make it as easy as possible for them by following the instructions below).
 - Clearly write your consignor number on each tag on the tag sheet and photocopy onto colored paper (all the same color, please use a color, off white & pale yellow are not acceptable).
 - □ Write an "R" in the lower right corner of the tags for those items you want returned to you if not sold.
 - □ BOOKS AND TOYS MAY NOT BE MARKED FOR RETURN.
 - Only gently used shoes will be displayed for purchase.
 - Please use the tag template on the last page and print at full size.
 - □ DO NOT USE Dot Labels, white or colored stickers/shipping labels/etc. They are too hard to read and to remove.
 - □ AGAIN, DO NOT USE WHITE PAPER. White paper for donations only.
- 3. Please submit only **Spring & Summer appropriate** items. *We are ok with pants, long sleeved shirts, but no overtly winter gear.
- 4. To tag clothing use a **Tagging Gun** (preferred) or safety pins (NOT straight pins or staples).
- **5**. To tag non-clothing items use strong tape. Items not tagged properly will not be accepted.
- 6. This is a consignment sale and a fundraiser, not a yard sale. Please price items to reflect at least 25% of the retail value.
- 7. Minimum tag price is \$1.00. You may bundle or bag smaller items such as socks, onesies, t-shirts, etc.
- 8. Must price items in increments of \$1.00. Items not priced in even \$1.00 increments will have their price rounded down.

- Suggested Pricing:
 - o Target, H&M, Amazon, and the equivalent-\$5.00-\$8.00
 - o Gap, Banana Republic, Ann Taylor, Zara, and the equivalent- \$8.00- \$17.00
 - o Tuckernuck, Nordstrom, Boden, and the equivalent- \$18.00 \$30.00
- Condition and brand dependent 30-40% of retail sells best

 - Submit a pre-addressed and stamped envelope. If you do not submit a SASE we will deduct \$2 from your proceeds.
- 2. Checks will be mailed within three (3) weeks of the end of the sale.
- 3. No checks will be issued for less than \$5.00.
