Project A.R.K.

A.R.K. stands for Advancing Resilient Khmer. We provide a dormitory, food, encouragement, mentorship, and vocational training in the construction industry for survivors of human trafficking. Many of our participants have come from the provinces near the borders of neighboring countries. Their exploitation largely exists due to predatory debt and financial bondage. Our program helps them achieve lasting freedom.

Street Children Ministry Program

Most of the CSCFO school students migrate from the province with the parents to work in the city. They live in a small rented room. They have low income, no stable job & housing. Children have no chance to study, so CSCFO opens the after school grade 1, 2 & 3 for free to those children. To provide an opportunity for the children education, we support CSCFO by train & empower the Education teamwork with the capacity building, providing Christian & social value class to the children, supporting the student study material, the backpack, the shoes and a school uniform. We have 60 students and 12 Education Team members. Together with the supports, we are bless to share the love of Christ through celebrating Christmas and Easter with CSCFO community, the children, the parent, and the neighbour, there are about 200 people participate in the evens every year.

With our newly built Moriah Educational Center, we started classes for English, computer and music. We have a total of 15 indigenous students. And in this building we can have trainings and seminars.
